ADJUDICATOR: Ms Gaye MacFarlane



Already as a young girl, Gaye possessed a broad musical taste. At the age of 16, she was engaged to perform in a regular television variety programme in Australia after which she completed a diploma in Operatic Arts at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music.

After 10 years of solo engagements in opera, Gaye was offered the role of Eva Peron, alternating with Patti Lupone, in the Australian Production of *Evita* directed by Hal Prince. This role started Gaye on a successful career in Musicals. Leading roles in ***Barnum***, ***Song and Dance***, ***They're Playing our Song*** and ***Sweeney Todd***, amongst others, followed.

Upon her arrival in Germany in 1985, she was offered the role of Anna in ***The Rink***. Leading roles followed throughout Germany, France, most notably at Theater des Westens in Berlin where she performed such roles as ***Sally Bowles*** in ***Cabaret*** alongside ***Hildegard Knef*** and ***Sally Durant*** in ***Follies*** with ***Eartha Kitt***.

On her return to Australia in 1992, Gaye again took up her operatic career, performing leading roles for Opera Australia in ***Cavalleria Rusticana***, ***Lohengrin***, ***Carmen***, ***Elektra***, ***Tannhäuser*** and in 2004, in Wagner's ***Ring Cycle***.

After her return in 2007 to Germany she performed, amongst others, in ***Jenufa*** and ***Sweeney Todd*** in Germany, ***Company*** and ***The Full Monty*** in Austria and ***Flashdance*** in Switzerland.

Today Gaye is living again in Australia and was nominated for a Sydney Theatre Critics award for her one woman cabaret show 'Stay a While with Weill' . She performed a second cabaret show on the music of the late Stephen Sondheim which premiered at the Prince of Wales Opera House in Gulgong.

Gaye is currently producing 4 short plays, which will premiere in Gulgong in November.

ADJUDICATOR: Ms Anne Stevens



ANNE STEVENS graduated from the Canberra School of Music in 1975 and gained her DCSM (Hons) in Performance in 1977 and BA(Mus) in 1978. She studied both piano and flute and her piano teachers include Lindsay Bingham and Larry Sitsky. Her flute studies were with Margaret Crawford and David Cubbin and post-tertiary studies with Vernon Hill and Geoffrey Collins.

Having attended master classes with Sergei Dorensky (piano) and James Galway (flute) her life-long passion for chamber music and performance was further stimulated and led her to pursue her highly successful career in chamber music and solo performance with great vigour.

In conjunction with her performance was her piano teaching, with her studio always in great demand. She has performed as piano soloist with the Sydney Symphony Orchestra (Young Performers), Sydney and Canberra Youth and Sydney Conservatorium Orchestra and as flute soloist with the Waverley Philharmonic Society, Orange Symphony, Macquarie Philharmonia and Maruki Orchestras.

Anne has been a tireless and energetic advocate of chamber music and instrumental performance and played an enormous role in the development of music in the Central Western Region of NSW whilst establishing her professional performing profile, as a hallmark of the region.

She plays regularly in Canberra as a Chamber musician in partnership with John Gould and Rita Woolhouse, runs a busy teaching and accompanying practice in Orange and currently teaches piano studies at Kinross Wolaroi School.

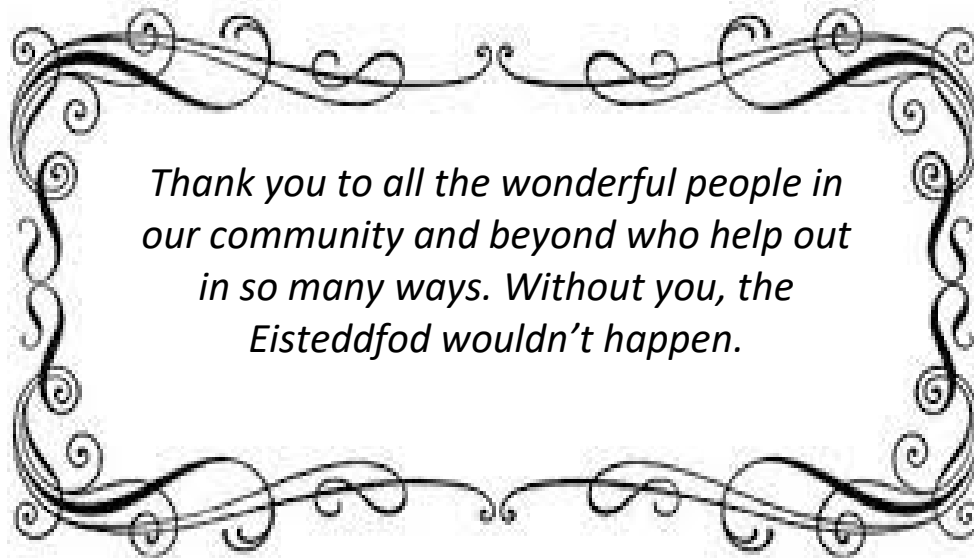

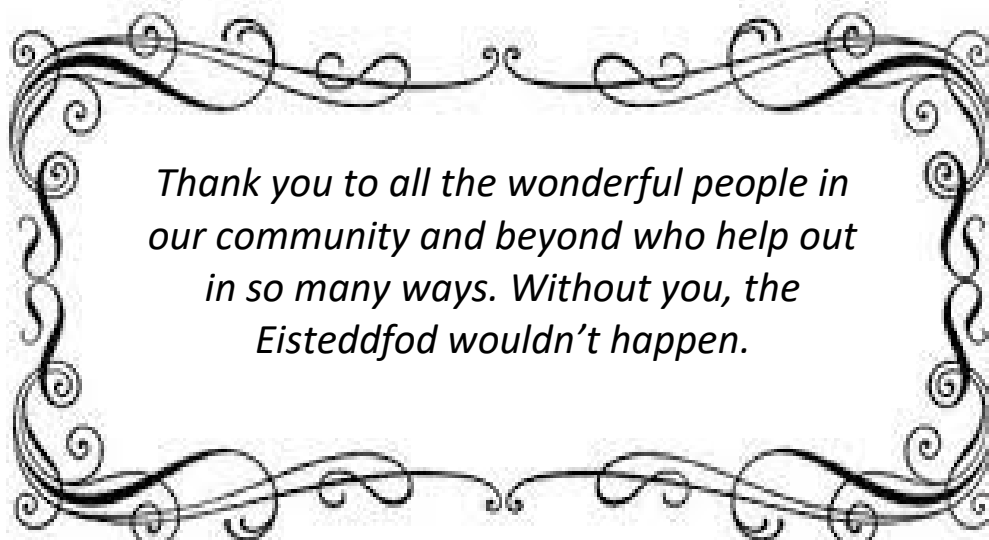

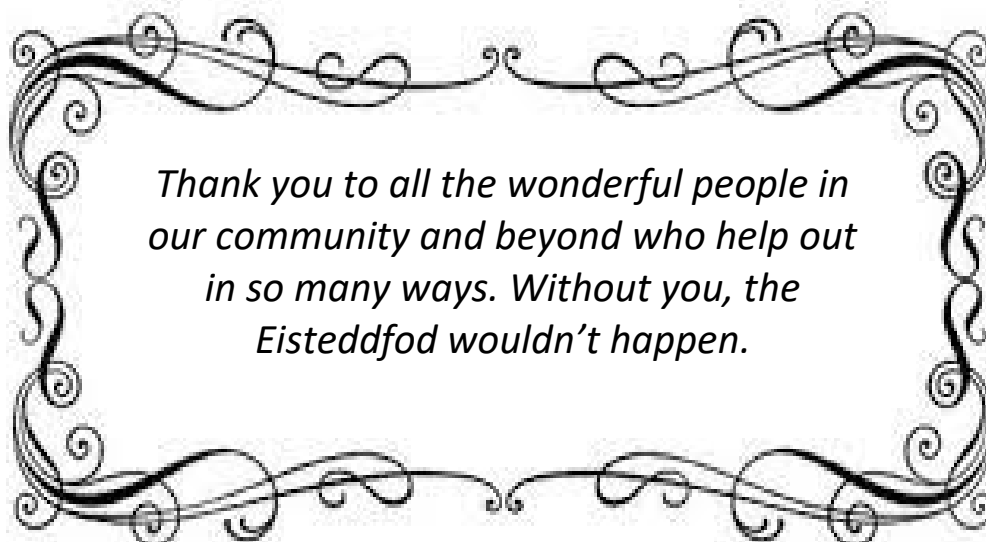
