ADJUDICATOR: Ms Hollie Hewett



Ms. Hollie Hewett has a Bachelor of Music majoring in Clarinet, and a Diploma of Singing Teaching. She is a Woodwind and Vocal Teacher and Band Director with the Mitchell Conservatorium in Bathurst. She also teaches Voice and Musical Theatre at The Dance Factory Performing Arts Centre in Bathurst. Her real love and passion are for musical theatre, which began when she became involved in the ensemble of Oliver with the Carillon Theatrical Society (CTS) in Bathurst in 2001.

Since then, she has been in over 30 shows either on stage or 'in the pit' (playing Clarinet, Flute, Oboe and Saxophone). Her most notable roles include Mary in Jesus Christ Superstar for CTS in 2005, Nessarose in Wicked for CTS in 2018; Florinda (stepsister) in Into the Woods for the Orange Theatre Company (OTC) in 2024 and Bonnie in Come from Away for OTC in 2025. Hollie has also turned her hand to Musical Directing in 2019 with The Addams Family Musical for CTS and later that year, Jesus Christ Superstar for the OTC and School of Rock for the OTC in 2023.

Hollie has been the music coordinator of the Bathurst Eisteddfod for the last 7 years and loves the opportunity local Eisteddfods give students. In 2025 she adjudicated at the Gold Coast Eisteddfod in the Small Ensembles, Rock Bands and Open Woodwind Sections. She hopes to be an encouraging and supportive teacher and create a safe space for students to be themselves and explore their musical creativity.

ADJUDICATOR: Mr John Martin



Mr. John Martin was born and raised in Mudgee before moving to Sydney to further his music studies. He then travelled to England on an Australian Council scholarship, to study ensemble piano and widen his experience. It was here that his international career began.

As pianist and Music Director, John has worked with many stars of the Australian and international concert and theatre scenes, including recitals and broadcasts with clarinettist Deborah de Graaff. He worked in trio combination with Deborah de Graaff and flautist Leah Lock as “Power Of Three”, with cellist Susan Blake, and singers including David Hobson and Marina Prior.

John toured China in June 2018 with Jane Rutter. 2022 saw performances of John’s solo show “Noel Coward—Master of Arts”, followed by further performances in 2023, and in March 2023 “Let’s be Outrageous—Noel Coward, Cole Porter and the Sophisticates”. John has also played several concerts in Sydney and Canberra with Turkish soprano Ayse Goknur Shanal.

John has championed the works of many Australian composers, especially Ann Carr-Boyd, and has for many years performed and recorded her music on the Wirripang label. Many of John’s own compositions are available through Wirripang Publications, including two volumes of piano works, “Livewire” and “Silk”. His published works also include many songs for voice with piano, duo works for violin and piano, and choral works.



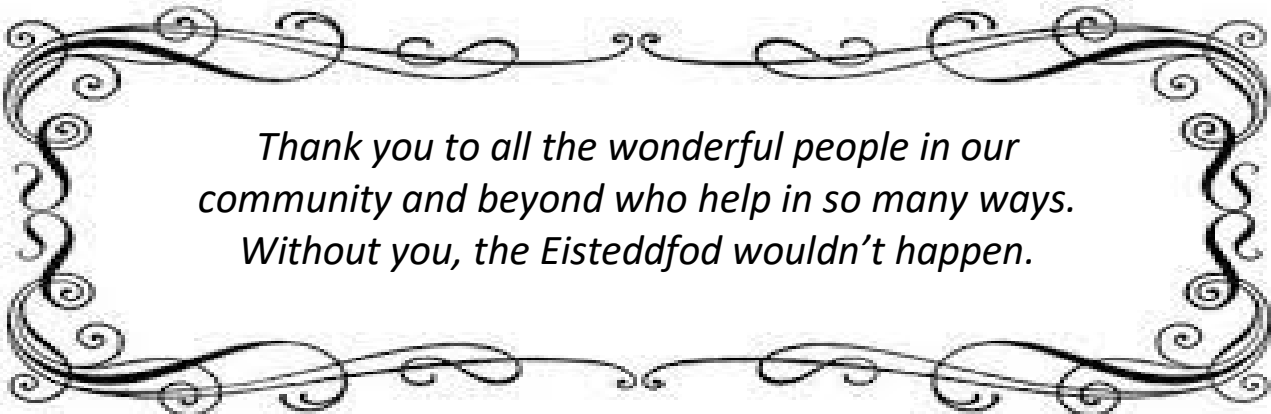
